RWAProgram – I will be emailing out a declaration form (when it's finalised) to be signed off and submitted with your final spreadsheet in April.

AW Woomargama report – Results from Alligator Weed inspection conducted 8th February 2010. Section 1 Dam Site - 3 plants found growing on eastern side of dam near where the removal by hand took place in 2008. Section 2 Middle creek section - 4 plants found along creek section in areas previously sprayed or removed by excavator. Inspection of areas previously sprayed showed no signs of growth. Small area in creek where old plant had been dug up revealed no growth in the hole that remained. Section 3 Bottom creek section - 15 plants found all away from the previously sprayed areas that had been staked. 6 of these plants were found approx 10 metres further downstream of the last control site. No plants have been seen in this area before and there is no water in this area to move fragments.

WoNS website – back up and running. We still have links to each of the WoNS pages as well as the National coordinators on our website.

Water Poppy – only NSW record is in Albury – the latest finding is about 1km downstream of the original infestation found in 2002. A detailed report will be in the next edition of CHINWAG. If anyone finds water poppy across the region - please send a sample to the herbarium with a copy to John Hosking I&I NSW



Egeria update on Murray River, Mildura – report

from Melissa freeman that Stephen Watts

elaborated on during his weedo update. 90Kms of elodea on the Murray river at Iraak Bend near Mildura – originally recorded in 2005 MDBC.

Report Template – we will be modifying the reporting template for future meetings to reflect the changes with the new process. Might even get some tips from the MERI training. It is hoped that the detail you put in your reporting (as I know a lot of time goes into them) can be incorporated into your end of year reporting. Once finalised, it will be available from the web.

Bitou bush update – Lake Menindee update and how it links in with Vic CfoC project – hybrid Bitou/Boneseed plants confirmed at Frankston, Vic. Update from Brett Norman, Senior Ranger, Broken Hill on Menindee Lake Bitou bush infestation:

- National Park infestation less than 60 plants
- Caravan Park, walked 500m of lake frontage 146 plants some 2m in height and 4m diameter
- After Caravan park, Sail boat club, disbanded (no water) unable to confirm tenure State water or Central Darling shire? From here to the connecting channel some 8kms scattered plants.

This infestation has been included in a CfoC bid – cross border with Victoria's Frankston infestation. The LMD CMA has come on board and Hillary Cherry (WoNS coordinator) is keeping me informed so all details can be included in our regional weed strategy (draft).

Hawkweed update – waiting to hear back from Victoria re: id training – stay tuned!

16th NSW Weeds Conference – expression of interest & the map are available on the extranet. Submissions for the next conference are being requested from the northeast division – map. Of interest – the 17th Conference will be held in the southwest region (US) all things going to plan.
