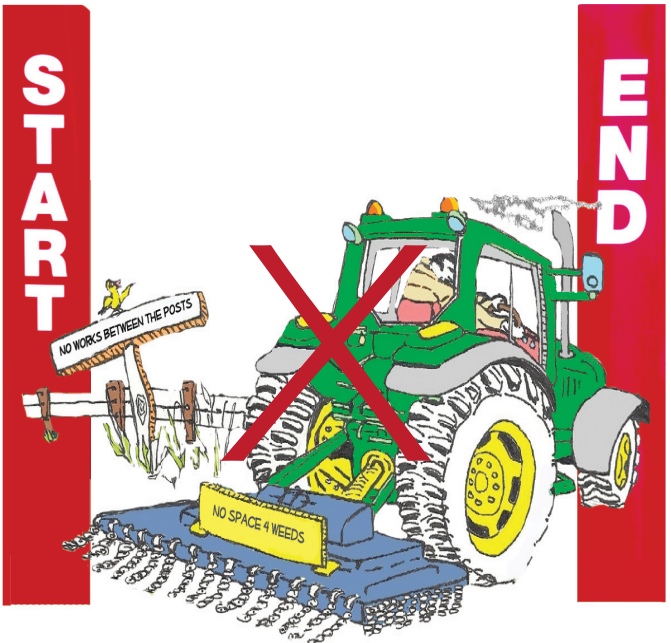


# RED GUIDE POSTS

Identifying noxious weed locations

# Red guide posts are being installed by vegetation managers along roadsides throughout NSW

## Why?

- To identify known locations of noxious weeds
- To alert machinery operators of the site
- To encourage liaison with local council weed officers on each site's requirements
- To prevent further spread of noxious weeds

## What can you do?



Avoid driving through infestations

Inspect and clean clothing and equipment

Report suspicious plants

## Remember!

Under Section 30(1) of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 “a person must not scatter or cause to be scattered on any land or water any notifiable weed material or other noxious weed material prescribed by the regulations, knowing it to be such weed material.”
